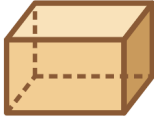
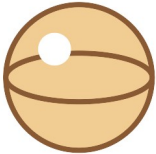
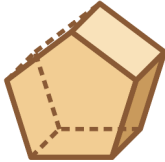


Prism Sort — Cut and Paste

Cut out the 8 object cards below. Sort each one into the correct column on the next page: Prism or Not a Prism.

Remember: a prism has two matching opposite faces, and the rest of its faces are rectangles.

Answer Key

1. Cube → Prism. Two opposite square faces, four rectangle faces.
2. Rectangular Prism → Prism. Two opposite rectangle faces, four more rectangles.
3. Triangular Prism → Prism. Two opposite triangle faces, three rectangle faces.
4. Pentagonal Prism → Prism. Two opposite pentagon faces, five rectangle faces.
5. Cylinder → Not a Prism. Two circle ends joined by one curved surface.
6. Cone → Not a Prism. One circle face and one curved surface to a point.
7. Sphere → Not a Prism. No flat faces — completely curved.
8. Square Pyramid → Not a Prism. One flat base, triangle faces meeting at a point.
